TASTE OF EPIC

EPIC, CABERNET SAUVIGNON, NAPA VALLEY 2016 30

We are proud to present our new vintage of Epic Cabernet Sauvignon. This is the ninth vintage that has been produced by winemaker Celia Welch, whose portfolio of clients has included top wineries such as Scarecrow, Corra, Lindstrom, Staglin, and Keever. She was named Food & Wine Magazine's 2008 Winemaker of the Year.

This wine is created from small lots with origins primarily in the western benchlands of Oakville, Yountville, and Rutherford, Napa Valley. Each lot was harvested by hand, fermented individually and aged in French oak prior to blending and bottling by hand, by the staff at EPIC Steak, in April 2018. A total of 55 cases were created. 95% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Petit Verdot.
